Basketball Frequently Asked Questions

When does the season start?

- Practices will begin November 1st, or shortly thereafter based on coach's schedules.

When is practice?

- Practice is dependant on the coach's time and gym availability. We do not practice on Wednesday nights to accommodate PRE students.

What day of the week are the games?

- All ESCRA games are played on Saturday starting the first 3 weekends in December before Christmas break. Games will resume in January and continue into mid-February.

What is the difference between ESCRA, Crosscheck, and PAA?

- ESCRA, East Shelby Church Recreation Association, is a non-profit organization that was formed to provide a recreation league for churches in Shelby County. Its mission is to provide and promote recreation between churches in Shelby County in a Christ-honoring environment.
- Crosscheck is based on similar principals as ESCRA. Crosscheck provides a more competitive environment for players with advanced skill levels. Teams are usually individual grade level based.
- For PAA, is sponsored by the Catholic Diocese of Memphis. The purpose of this organization shall be to: (a) promote the ongoing development of all participants within the framework of the stated philosophy and the program's goals (b) coordinate the sports program with the educational programs in member churches/schools; and (c) develop and maintain consistent regulations and standards for behavior during all sponsored activities.

Is there a "School Only" team?

- **NO!** All teams participate as a part of the Incarnation Church Parish. The team may represent the school, but it will consist of players from both the parish and the school. We do not intentionally create teams off school only or parish only players. The purpose of the program is to promote fellowship and friendship between all players.

Does my child need to tryout for the team?

- Only competitive teams require tryouts, but only if there are more players wishing to play in the competitive program than there are positions available for the team.

What is a Competitive team?

- This is in reference to League Sponsored Competitive teams only with PAA, ESCRA, or Crosscheck. Players actively playing with middle school or high school teams are ineligible to participate with Incarnation due to league rules.
- Competitive teams require the program having a volunteer willing to coach in a specific age group (generally grades 5-8 for PAA and grades 1-8 for ESCRA/Crosscheck).
- They do not enforce player time limits. Rec teams require 50% play rules for players. For competitive teams, it is coach's discretion.
- There are no restrictions to limit run away scoring.

My child does not have the skills to play on a competitive team, but for his/her age the only team available is a competitive team; can he/she still play on a rec team?

- We try to create every opportunity for your child to play. Generally, they can play up with older teams, or through special request, can play on a younger team. This must be done in advance of the start of the season. If such a situation should exist, you will be contacted to discuss options.

Does my child need to have a physical to participate?

- YES. All participants must have, or have had a sports physical in the past year.
- A sports physical may find abnormalities which you may not be aware that can affect the safety and health of your child when participating in sports activities.
- Any physician's office or clinic can conduct the physical.
- It **does not** have to be on a TSSAA form. The physician's office or clinic may have their own form for sports physicals. It must be signed by the physician, or person qualified for conducting the physical.
- Kroger's and Walgreens' pharmacies offer this service for a small fee. (approx. \$20).
