CAN CATHOLICS BE CREMATED? In 1963 the Vatican lifted the ban on cremation. It is now an acceptable practice for Catholics. In 1997, the Vatican approved new liturgical norms allowing for the cremated remains to be present at a funeral Mass and the remains are to be treated with the same reverence as a whole body in a casket. Spreading the cremated ashes is still forbidden.

PERPETUAL ADORATION...BECOME AN ADORER... to be in Jesus' presence once a week for a holy hour...to talk to Him...tell Him your concerns...to listen to Him...and to adore Him. Come and receive His blessings!

Adoration takes place 24/7 in the *Blessed Sacrament Chapel*, which is located next to the St. Therese of Lisieux Chapel. *All are welcome at any time!* The door is usually closed, but come right in for any amount of time. 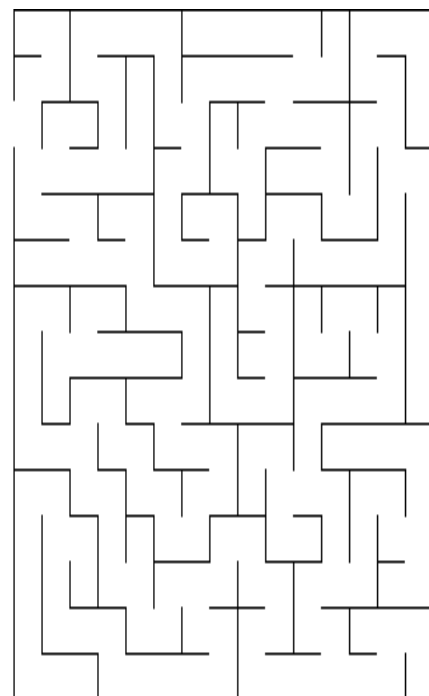
