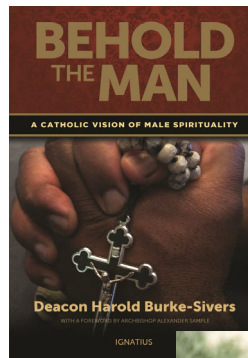

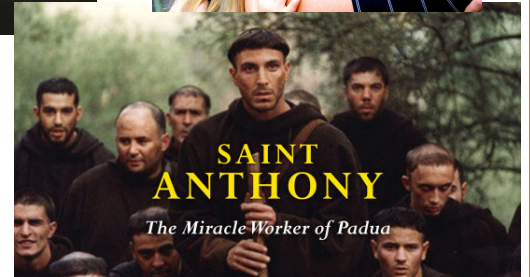

CHILDREN'S FAITH FORMATION

P.R.E. REGISTRATION for 2017-18: Still taking registrations for 2017-18. Forms found on line and in the PRE office. Classes are for children 3 yrs to 8th grade, High School Sacramental prep and RCIC.

Sacramental Prep: The Diocese requires that all students have two consecutive years of sacramental prep before receiving the sacraments. Therefore students must be enrolled in 1st and 7th grades in order to receive 1st Reconciliation and 1st Communion in 2nd grade and Confirmation in 8th grade.
